PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- (1) To develop and to agree on general, organizational (policy) and technical (standards) frameworks for implementation and using of e-learning at Croatian universities
- (2) To shape and establish e-learning support centers at Croatian universities (members of the project consortium), as well as network of experts to foster and facilitate e-learning projects
- (3) To demonstrate appropriate usage of e-learning technology (by conducting pilot projects) and to promote e-learning, as powerful tool for improvement of university education

EXPECTED RESULTS (1) (OUTPUTS & OUTCOMES)

Policy & standards

- University vision (declaration) on e-learning (why we want e-learning and what we want to achieve)
- University policy on e-learning (long term motivation and goals for implementation of e-learning, organization of support, level of support, evaluation and valorization procedures, sustainability of "e-learning system" /especially continuous "support lines"/, reliability of "e-learning infrastructure", ...)
- Implementation plan for e-learning deployment, including business plans (models) for e-learning support centers
- ◆ Technical framework set of standards, rules and guidelines for university elearning projects

E-learning support centers

- Full-time staff trained in the area of management and implementation of elearning
- Technically equipped locations for e-learning support centers
- Clear business and sustainability models
- Publicly available list of services, terms of use and service level agreements of elearning support centers



UNIVERSITY of ZAGREB (I)

- ❖ ⅙... overall project successes and failings
- continuous "political" support of university management
- raised awareness on opportunities of e-learning at most of faculties
- University strategy for E-learning developed in period February-June
 2007 and approved by Senate in June 2007 after public debate
- E-learning (support) center (CEU) established within Srce with 3 FTE (re-allocation of the Srce resources)
- © CEU has the authority of the central university office (to monitor and foster the implementation of the E-learning strategy)
- permanent University committee for E-learning appointed by Senate
- official e-learning contact points (two persons: vice-dean and e-learning coordinator) were appointed at each of 33 university departments

UNIVERSITY of ZAGREB (II)

- common university platform established MERLIN (based on Moodle) - available to all departments (institutionally), but also to individual teachers
- support & materials available for MERLIN users
- introductory course for teachers ready to start
- university network for e-learning established (coordinators, support teams, teachers, students, "fans")
- Popodne@CEU (Afternoon@CEU) every 3rd Monday at 4 p.m.





















UNIVERSITY of ZAGREB (III)

- survey of the situation on e-learning (readiness, level of implementation, expectations) at all 33 departments (2007) department's management view(!)
- request and survey of department's plans for the implementation of the e-learning in academic year 2007/2008
