# What is a screencast?

- Screencast is a recording of computer display output
- Usually contains also the lecturers commentaries in audio form
- The output is a video file

## ... save time

- it is possible to deliver lectures with many groups just once,
- also those students, who missed the auditory lecture, can participate
- or in other words the teacher can avoid speeking several times about the same subject.
- already recorded screencast can be usually used several years.
- ... in seminars concentrate to the solving of concrete problems of concrete students.

### BEST SCREENCASTING TOOL

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ScreenCasting is the new hip term for recording movies of your computer desktop as you demonstrate some program.

The name is a bit misleading because you aren't actually broadcasting demonstrations live - you're recording movies to post on your website (or send via email, etc.). But then when the **cult-of-apple** types decide they need a new term for an old thing, there's no sense trying to fight it and you might as well go along for the ride.

Regardless of whether you call it screencasting or **demo movie recording**, a new breed of tools (combined with the market penetration of Macromedia Flash) is making it easier and easier for home users to produce software demonstrations.

After an exhaustive review of screencasting software, which involved making dozens of demo movies spanning several full hours of video, we narrowed down the list of best screencasting tools to a small handfull. We tried hard to choose a single best tool from this set of top contenders, but in the end we decided that we couldn't pick a single winner. Instead, this review represents the first **shared Best-in-Class award** at DonationCoder.com:




## How difficult is the



recording of a screencast?

- Camtasia Studio has a PowerPointi package
- Parameters
  - How many frames per second?
  - What should be the audio quality?
  - Do we record also the teachers face and movements (picture-in-picture possibility)
  - Do we display PIP also during the recording?
- After determination of those parameters you just need to deliver your lecture as good as possible <sup>(3)</sup>





# What really takes time?



- Chosing the place of recordings
  - Background should be in light colours
  - Without many small details
- Chosing the best clothing
  - Depends on the quality of a videocamera used
  - In general, clothing in light colours give also here the best result

# What really takes time?

- Choice of output format and data rate: it is a compromise between good quality and possibilities of an average user computer
  - The more the data rate the more you can put information inside.
  - What formats are supported by users computer?
  - What datarate is possible to play in users computer?
  - What is the internet band rate between video server and users computer?
