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PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- (1) To develop and to agree on general, organizational (policy) and technical (standards) frameworks for implementation and using of e-learning at Croatian universities
- (2) To shape and establish e-learning support centers at Croatian universities (members of the project consortium), as well as network of experts to foster and facilitate elearning projects
- (3) To demonstrate appropriate usage of e-learning technology (by conducting pilot projects) and to promote e-learning, as powerful tool for improvement of university education

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EXPECTED RESULTS (1) (OUTPUTS & OUTCOMES)

* Policy & standards

- University vision (declaration) on e-learning (why we want e-learning and what we want to achieve)
- University **policy** on e-learning (long term motivation and goals for implementation of e-learning, organization of support, level of support, evaluation and valorization procedures, sustainability of "e-learning system" /especially continuous "support lines"/, reliability of "e-learning infrastructure", ...)
- Implementation plan for e-learning deployment, including business plans (models) for e-learning support centers
- Technical framework set of standards, rules and guidelines for university elearning projects

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EXPECTED RESULTS (2) (OUTPUTS & OUTCOMES)

* E-learning support centers

- Full-time staff trained in the area of management and implementation of elearning
- Technically equipped locations for e-learning support centers
- Clear business and sustainability models
- Publicly available list of services, terms of use and service level agreements of elearning support centers

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- Pilot project
 - 3-4 pilot projects accepted and fully supported by the EQIBELT project
 - Support to ongoing e-learning projects

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



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OVERALL PROJECT STATUS AND ACHIVEMENTS

- a series of high-quality knowledge transfer & experience / knowledge exchange events with 40-50+ participants
 - good knowledge flow EU > CRO (study visits)
 - good promotion of e-learning and dissemination of information on e-learning and EQIBELT project
- Support from university managements
- Strategic documents still under development (RI O)
 - Support centers nor defined /not operational yet
 - no real new resources allocated to support centers
 - Staff not trained for e-learning support ⇔ training in CARNet's ELA program canceled by EC

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EDUCATION QUALITY IMPROVEMENT

- ✤ ₲... overall project successes and failings
- (too) long period of university management reelection
- © continuous "political" support of university management
- **©** raised awareness on opportunities of e-learning at most of faculties
- vision/strategy team (committee) will be appointed at February Senate session and plan is to propose strategy to Senate until May / June
- C e-learning (support) center with status of university central office will be formally established by Senate in February; Sandra Kučina & 1-2 additional FTE (re-allocation of Srce resources); first steps: establishment of Moodle LMS and organizing support for it; establishing university network of e-learning support teams and "fans", active and "pushing" participation in creation of e-learning vision & strategy

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
